**They have managed to acquire a mower.**

**The club would like to ask if it is possible to borrow the park tractor approximately once a week from March to September. The Tractor is more than enough powerful for the mower with only 12hp being required to pull the mower. The tractor is 23hp.**

**Drivers will be limited to two only with Stuart Robinson being the main one. The Tractor is insured for the road. On the rare chance of any accidents occurring this will be covered under the Cricket Clubs Public Liability Cover and a document will be drawn up stating this is the case.**
